Year 4 Creative Week – 5-9 November 2018

This term in history, Year 4 are learning about invaders and settlers. Our focus after half term is the Romans and Celts, and we would like to make learning come to life by creating a Roman school from Monday 5 - Friday 9 November 2018. During this time we will carry out a variety of Roman themed activities in class, including lessons, army drills, making mosaics and learning about the Roman gods.

We would like all the children in Year 4 to come to school throughout this week wearing a Roman tunic, as Roman children wore to school, to make this experience as lifelike as possible. This can be as simple as an old sheet tied with a belt around the middle. Many children in previous years have used the same costume they wore for the Year 3 Greek Week. If you would like any help with the costume please do speak to us.

On Wednesday 7 November we will be visiting Butser Hill Ancient Farm, and children will not be expected to wear their costume on this day. As stated in our previous letter, children will not be required to wear school uniform for this trip and instead should wear suitable outdoor clothing as the day involves taking part in practical activities. Children should also bring a change of footwear, including a plastic carrier bag to put their dirty shoes in at the end of the day.

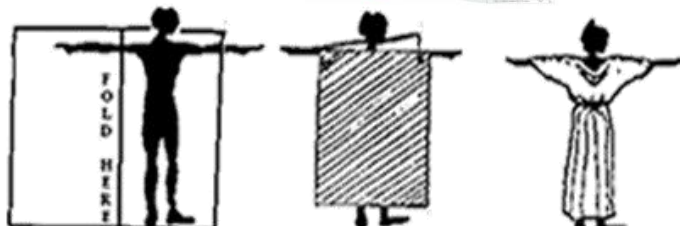
