**Visit to Butser Hill Ancient Farm**

This term Year 4 are learning about the invaders and settlers in Britain during ancient times. Part of this work is based on a visit to Butser Hill Ancient Farm. This visit will take place on Wednesday 7 November 2018 within school hours. Children will need a packed lunch that day. They will also need to wear suitable outdoor clothing for the weather. As the day involves children taking part in practical activities and they may well get dirty, they will not be required to wear their school uniform. They must also bring a change of footwear including a plastic carrier bag to put their dirty shoes in at the end of the day.

The cost per child, inclusive of entrance fee and transport by coach is £14.40 The cost also includes four workshop activities where children become archaeologists and gain hands-on experience at finding out about the past. The children will take part in activities such as wattle and daub, making Celtic jewellery and chalk carving. There will also be a chance to see and explore a reconstructed Celtic roundhouse and a Roman Villa. If we do not receive enough income from voluntary contributions, this trip may need to be cancelled.
