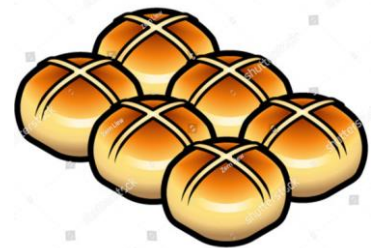
We will visit the church on Wednesday 3 April 2019. The visit will last about 2 hours during school time and the children will walk to the church.
