Dear Parents,

Year 3 have been given the opportunity to work with DP World from the Southampton container port during our study of Southampton. Volunteers from DP world have been visiting the year 3 children and sharing insights into what it is like to work at the docks and the types of jobs they do. So far, we have heard from a HR manager and a Health and Safety Officer. The children have thoroughly enjoyed these visits and gained a lot from them.

DP world have kindly offered all year 3 classes the opportunity to visit the docks. We will therefore be visiting the container port on **Tuesday 9 July 2019**. DP World have agreed to pay for the coaches, and so there is no charge for this visit. **However, we will need a permission slip returned for each child in order for them to go on the trip.**

On the day, children will be required to wear school uniform as normal. They should order lunches or bring sandwiches as normal as we will be back in time for lunch.

We will leave school at approximately 9:00am. We will then be treated to a bus tour of the docks with a guide from DP world before returning to school at approximately 11:30am. The children will not be able to get off the coach at the docks, but this is an excellent opportunity for them to see the docks working and to bring our work on the docks to a conclusion.
