This week in English lessons.

This week we are walking to Portswood. In English we will be looking at some of the shops and buildings within the high street and writing sentences to tell people about the places they may find.

Within their writing the children will be continuing to focus on using capital letters, full stops and finger spaces while using their neat handwriting.

This week in Maths our lessons will focus on addition and subtraction.

This week the children will be developing their skills to solve mathematical problems.

They will be using resources to support their learning and will be encouraged to work in an organised way.
