This week in English our lessons will continue to be linked to Goldilocks and the 3 Bears.

The children will be learning to make porridge this week. They will follow step by step instructions as a class. The children will then be writing their own instructions for making porridge. They will get the process in the correct order and use words such as first, next and then (adverbials of time). They will also use imperatives (bossy words) such as put, stir, pour etc.

The children will also be writing a sorry letter from Goldilocks to the 3 bears.
