Morning routines - now that your children are familiar with their new classrooms, we ask that you say goodbye to them at the entrance to the infant building or at the classroom door. We would like your child to come into their classroom independently. Thank you for your cooperation.

On Friday mornings you are welcome to come into class 8:45-8:55am to share a book with your child.

This week in English our lessons will continue to be linked to our transition unit - Superheroes.

The children will be writing speech bubbles about what the different superheroes might say. The children will be focussing on using their sounds to write words. They will be encouraged to use finger spaces and include capital letters and full stops.

We will also be reading 'Supertato' story and making a poster linked to the book.

This week in Maths our lessons will focus on 1 more/1 less than.

The children will be reading a number to 20 and counting out that number of objects. The focus will be on the children's accuracy when counting the objects. They will then work out what one more and one less is.

They will also be revisiting 2d shapes.
