



Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 11th November 2019



This week our English lessons will continue to be linked to the story of 'Dear Zoo'.

This week the children will be making a wanted poster for an escaped animal. They will describe the animal using adjectives.

The children will also be making their own versions of the book - including adding their own flaps to hide the animals.

All their work in English consolidates learning on using their sounds, finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

This week in maths our lessons will focus on ordering numbers.

The children will be focussing this week on ordering numbers to 20 and beyond. They will be ordering numbers from smallest to largest. They will also be ordering numbers where some are missing in a sequence.

e.g. order these numbers from smallest to largest - 6, 3, 10, 2, 14, 11.

They will also find missing numbers in a number sequence.

Phonics sounds of the week:
ear, air, ure

Key words of the week:
my the

Please note the children are expected to be able to read and spell these words by the end of Year 1.

How you can help at home

- ✓ Play number bond tennis with your child. You say a single digit number and they must say the pair required to make a total of 10. For example, parent says "7", so child must say "3".
- ✓ Encourage your child to use expression when reading at home.
