




Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 14th October 2019



This week in English our lessons will be based around the story 'We're going on a bear hunt.'

The children will be reading the story and then going on their own bear hunts around the school. They will describe what they see and hear.


They will then change parts of the original story so that they choose which animal they are looking for e.g. 'We're going on a donkey hunt'.

They will describe the animal and the places they visit in their written work.

This week in Maths our lessons will focus on subtraction.

The children will be learning how to subtract one number from another in maths this week.

They will do so using physical objects, such as counters, tens frames and a number line.
