Further to the meeting on Monday 14 October 2019, please find the key information for the Year 6 Avon Tyrrell trip listed below.

Monday 11 November 2019

- Children should arrive at school at the normal time. They should take their suitcases to the main hall.
- Parents should leave the school site as usual however you are very welcome to return to wait outside the school at 10.30am when the children depart.
- Medication must be handed to Mr Leonard in a named envelope. **If your child uses an inhaler, 2 inhalers should be provided please.**
- Pocket money must be handed to Mr May in a named envelope.
- Lunch will be provided at Avon Tyrrell – you do not need to provide a packed lunch.

Friday 15 November 2019

- We will leave Avon Tyrrell on Friday 15 November 2019 at 1.30pm and arrive back at Portswood Primary School at approximately 2.30pm.
- The children will return into school with their teachers. Parents can then collect them from their teachers as soon as they have arrived back.
