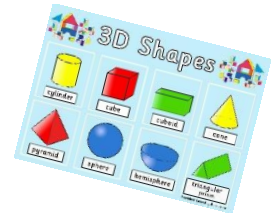




# Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 16<sup>th</sup> December 2019



**This week our English lessons will be focused on writing acrostic poems.**

The children's acrostic poems will be based on winter. Therefore the beginning of the week will be spent thinking of all words the children can think of to describe the season.

The children will then turn their ideas into an acrostic poem. There will be a focus on using adjectives to make their poems interesting and exciting.

**This week in Maths our lessons will focus on 3d shapes.**

The children will be learning the names of different 3d shapes such as sphere, cube, cuboid, cone and pyramid.

They will think about where they see these shapes all around them e.g. a dice is a cube.

They will make models using 3d shapes and then label them.
