Week beginning: 21st October 2019



Next week the children will continue to use 'We're going on a bear hunt' as a stimulus for their writing.

The children will be recapping their knowledge of what a recount is. They will be writing a recount of when we went on our own bear hunt around the school! The children will get the events in the correct order and use adverbials of time such as first, next and then.

They will also be completing a piece of independent writing about the bear hunt story. They will be using their knowledge of sounds, finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.

Next week in maths the children will be consolidating all that they have learnt so far this term.

We will be looking back at previous learning and making sure that all areas have been fully understood.

We will cover addition, subtraction, shape, time and positional language.
