Spot the Number



This week in English our lessons will continue to be linked to a Teddy Bear's Picnic.

After our picnic on Monday the children will be writing sentences about what they saw. They will be encouraged to use their sounds and form their letters correctly.

They will also be writing a recount of their time at the picnic. This involves them putting the events of the afternoon in order and then writing about each part.

Phonics sounds of the week:

ck, qu, sh, ch

Key words of the week:

be he

This week in maths our lessons will focus on number representation.

This week the children will be looking at a variety of different ways that numbers can be made or displayed.

They will be recognising numbers in tallies, dice, dominoes, tens frames and many more.

The greater understanding your child has of numbers, the number system and how they can be represented will support future work in applying these numbers to solve problems.

Collectable cards

These cards (Pokemon, Disney Heroes etc) are becoming a frequent problem during lesson times. We ask that these cards are **not** brought into school as the children are finding it difficult to use them only at playtimes.

- ✓ Lots of children are struggling at the moment to get themselves changed for PE without adult support. They are finding it difficult to get their clothes the right way round, do up buttons and pull on tights. Please can they practise doing this independently at home!
