This week our English lessons will be linked to the story of 'The Little Red Hen'.

This week the children will be learning to finish writing the story of the Little Red Hen - they have done a great job so far.

They will also be making some bread and then writing instructions to show how they did it.

This week in maths our lessons will focus on mass.

This week the children will be using balance scales to work out which objects are lighter and heavier than each other.

They will spend lots of time practically weighing objects and using mathematical language such as lightest and heaviest.

They will then move on to ordering different objects according to how much they weigh.

We will be using our assessments to target Phase 4 sounds we feel the children would benefit some more time on.
