




Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 2nd March 2020



The week, our English lessons will continue to be linked to our History lessons about a Victorian school child.

During this week the children will be experiencing what it would have been like to be in a classroom over 100 years ago.

They will then learn what a diary is and what the features of a diary are. This will prepare them to write a diary entry in role as a Victorian school child.

This week, our Maths lessons will focus on multiplication.

During this week the children will be introduced to multiplication as repeated addition. They will look at repeated addition represented with pictures and number sentences. They will also be using the phrase 'lots of' to help them explain repeated addition number sentences.

For example:



$$2 + 2 + 2 = 6$$

$$3 \text{ lots of } 2 = 6$$

Phonics sounds of the week:

Alternative Pronunciations

a (as in ay e.g. acorn)

a (as in o e.g. wasp)

e (as in ee e.g. me)

Key words of the week:

love come

Please note the children are expected to be able to read and spell these words by the end of Year 1.
