In addition to this, the children will have the opportunity to participate in a variety of activities from several different workshops including candle making and becoming medieval doctors.

During the afternoon they will experience a banquet and a tournament. We have the children's permission forms to be able to eat food, although it is important that if there are any changes e.g. allergies then your child's class teacher **must** be notified as they will be eating food during the banquet.
