

Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 10th February 2020



This week our English lessons will be writing labels and captions in preparation for our Toy Museum.

Throughout the week the children will be looking at all the work we have completed for our 'Toys' topic this half term and deciding what they would like to display in their museum.

We will be discussing what a label and caption are and where we find them.

The children will use their knowledge of sounds and key words to write informative sentences.

Our grammar focus will be joining **words** and joining **clauses** using *and*.

This week in Maths our lessons will focus on subtraction.

Similar to our week on addition last week the children will be using tens frames as a practical resource to solve subtraction questions.

The children will be showing subtraction practically and also looking at completed tens frames and writing number sentences to represent what they see.

Towards the end of the week the children will use this knowledge to solve subtraction word problems.
