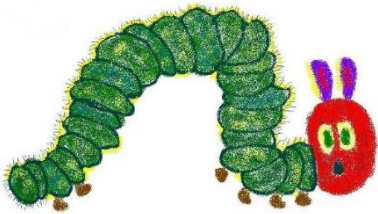
Week beginning: 9th March 2020
