


Year 1 Learning Journey

Week beginning: 9th March 2020







The week, our English lessons will be linked to the story 'Handa's surprise'.


During the week the children will be exploring different fruits. The children will be exploring what the fruit looks like, feels like and tastes like.

The children will then use their experiences to generate adjectives to describe the fruit. We will also be encouraging the children to choose the most appropriate adjective for each fruit to help them develop the range of vocabulary they are using within their writing.

This week, our Maths lessons will focus on division.

During this week the children will be introduced to division as sharing. They will look at simple problems and begin by practically sharing objects into hoops. This will lead to recording their sharing by drawing pictures then circles and dots.

For example: $6 \div 2$





Phonics sounds of the week:

Alternative Pronunciations

i (as in igh e.g. mind)o (as in oa e.g. mobile)u (as in ue e.g. unicorn)u (as in oo e.g. bush)

Key words of the week: Some once

Please note the children are expected to be able to read and spell these words by the end of Year 1.

How you can help at home

As we are learning to share (divide) in maths this week you could do lots of practical problem solving with your child at home to help them understand the concept. For example, if there are 12 grapes in the bowl and we share them between mum and dad how many will they have each? You could then challenge them to share between different amounts of people. For example, how many would 3 people get?
