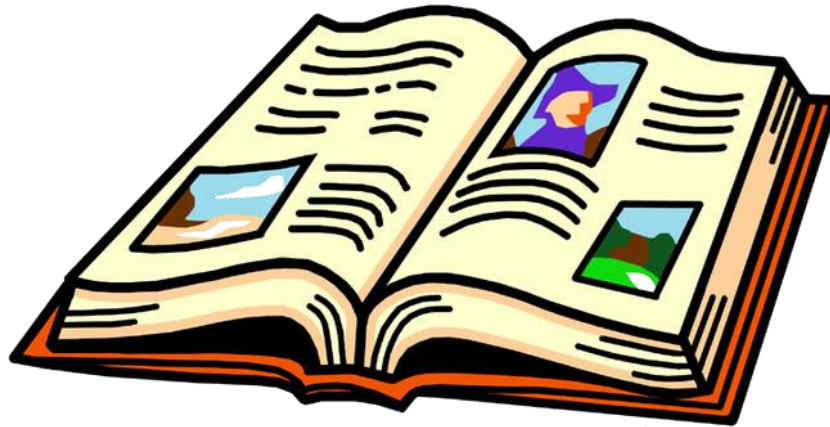

Punctuation - Use capital letters, full stops and introduce


