## Home Challenge

Please help your child practise taking their shoes and socks on and off independently. This will help them be ready to learn during PE!

### Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



#### Pronunciation Phrase - g

Give me a big smile that shows your teeth. Press the middle of your tongue to the top and back of your mouth; push your tongue down and forward to make the sound **g g g**



#### Pronunciation Phrase - o

Make your mouth into a round shape and say **o o o**



#### Pronunciation Phrase - c

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say **c c c**



#### Pronunciation Phrase - k

Open your mouth into a little smile; make your tongue flat and move it up towards the top of your mouth to say **k k k**

**We will be orally blending words.** Can you hear the phonemes in these words? Can you listen and then repeat the word?

d - o - g

c - a - t

n - o - d

k - i - d

t - o - p

d - i - g

**We will be practising tricky words.** Can you spot the tricky part of the word?
