How you can help at home

- ✓ Practise counting to 20 with your child. Can they recognise the numbers 1-20.
- ✓ Look out for numbers in the world around you, can your child spot the numbers on a bus or a road sign?
- ✓ Keep encouraging your child to practise their name, this could be 5 minutes a day. Make sure they have a capital letter at the start and the rest of their name is in lower case.
