Visit to Butser Ancient Farm

As part of their learning about the invaders and settlers of ancient Britain, Year 4 will be visiting Butser Ancient Farm on **Friday 6 November 2026** during the school day.

The cost of the trip is **£27.20** per child, which includes transport, admission and four interactive workshops. During the visit, the children will become archaeologists, taking part in hands-on activities such as mosaic and Celtic jewellery making. They will also have the opportunity to explore a reconstructed Celtic roundhouse and a Roman villa.
