Phonemes we will be focusing on this week in school -



Pronunciation Phrase - ff

Open your lips a little; put your teeth on your bottom lip and push the air out to make the sound fffff fffff

Digraph (ff) two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - Il

Open your mouth a little; put your tongue up to the top of your mouth, behind your teeth, and press **UIII**

Digraph (II) two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - ss

Show your teeth and and let the s hiss out ssssss ssssss

Digraph (ss) two letters, one sound



Pronunciation Phrase - j

Pucker your lips and show your teeth use your tongue as you say **]]]**

We will be reading and writing words. Can you spot segment and blend these words and spot this week's phonemes?
