Gingerbread man recipe

You will need:

175g plain flour

50g butter

2 $\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoons of ginger

90g of sugar

2 tablespoons of golden syrup

1 egg

$\frac{1}{2}$ teaspoon of bicarbonate soda



- 1) First put the flour, butter, ginger and bicarbonate in a mixing bowl and mix until crumbly.
- 2) Then add the sugar, syrup and egg until it looks like pastry.
- 3) Roll out and use gingerbread cutters for shape.
- 4) Put in a pre-heated oven at 180 degrees for 15 minutes until golden.
- 5) Enjoy!
