<u>What are we learning?</u> This week we will be looking at the story, 'Goldilocks and the Three Bears.' The children will be joining in with and re-telling the story and size ordering bowls. They will be doing activities based around the story such as making bowls out of clay, exploring hard, soft and rough materials, as well as learning the 'Goldilocks and Three Bears' song.		<u>Please remember</u> to send your child to Nursery with a named coat, as our learning takes place inside and outside in all weathers. How to help at home <u>To help improve gross motor skills</u> Make a house out of a large cardboard box and other materials. Make sure you have a window, floor, door and ceiling to point to. Or Make up a dance that includes an action for winding up the bobbin and pointing to different places in the room <u>To help improve fine motor skills</u> Wind and unwind various types of thread around old cotton reels. Or		

Thread pasta and cotton reels onto string to make necklaces.

Practice writing their name using the name card that we sent home before Christmas. (If your child is starting school in September!)
