What are we learning?

How to help at home

<u>To help improve gross motor skills</u> Make large boats and oars from cardboard boxes, sticks/canes. Sit inside and practise rowing the boat.

Or

Paint a huge river on a large piece of paper for toy boats to go along.

To help improve fine motor skills

Decorate a piece of card. Fold it to make a boat and then sail it in water.

Or

Make crocodiles from playdough. Add pointy teeth and googly eyes.

To help improve number recognition

Find the number 1 on your walk home, or when you go to the shops. Where can you find it? On number plates, on houses, on price tickets, etc
