

How to help at home

To help improve gross motor skills

Use large outdoor construction materials to create a wall and role-play Humpty Dumpty falling off the wall. Or

#### To help improve fine motor skills

Make a Humpty Dumpty using a boiled egg and decorative resources.

Cut out an egg template for Humpty and put it back together using plasters
