New learning resources for this week have been made available for those families who have requested access to them, and some new video lessons have been added onto the homework page too. In addition to this, we have also included some more online resources to the list on the school website.

One of these is called 'Oak National Academy'. This is a government funded online classroom and resource hub. This online classroom provides free lessons and resources for pupils from reception through to year 6 and beyond. As part of a collective response to the crisis, 40 teachers will be producing over 180 free online lessons each week, which will cover a range of subjects from English and maths to arts and languages. These can be dipped into as much or as little as you like and can be used to supplement what the school is already making available on-line.
