Dear Parents,

The government have made changes to the statutory elements of Personal Social Health & Economic (PSHE) primary curriculum. These statutory changes need to be in place no later than September 2021.

As part of this process, we have explored our current curriculum and identified where alterations would need to be made so that the school fulfils its statutory obligations within this subject. In addition to this, we have begun the process of rewriting the Relationship & Sex Education Policy of the school.

Accompanying this letter is that policy. Within it, you will find appendices that identify the alterations we are proposing to make in each year group to fulfil the requirements of the new curriculum changes. These appendices also identify the non-statutory elements of the PHSE curriculum that parents are entitled to withdraw their children from if they wish.
