Dear parents,

As you may now be aware the Prime Minister has just announced a national lockdown that now means primary schools will close to all but the families of key workers and vulnerable pupils. Due to the late timing of this announcement, I have taken the decision to close the school **to all pupils** for tomorrow.

This will allow us to carry out the necessary work to be able to welcome into school, children of key worker families and vulnerable children as of **Wednesday 6 January 2021**.

During tomorrow you will be receiving further communication from the school. This will give you the opportunity to inform the school of your key worker status so that we can make provision for your children to attend school.

In addition to this, for those children who will now be working from home, you will be receiving emails with logins and instructions on how your children will be able to access online learning whilst we remain in lockdown. This work will begin to be available as of **Wednesday 6 January 2021**.

I appreciate none of this is ideal for any of us, but I hope that by continuing to work and support one another we can get through these challenging times.
