This year World Book Day coincides with one of our planned Digital Down Days. Therefore, you will receive suggestions on how to embrace all things book related.

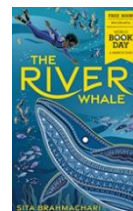
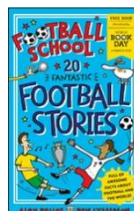
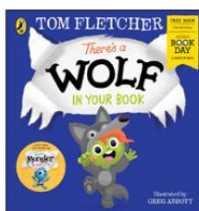


2) Dressing up as a book character
