Titanic Day – Wednesday 5 May 2021



This half term the Year 1 children will be engaging in a topic based around the sinking of the Titanic. To excite and engage the children in their learning, we would like them to take part in a Titanic day on Wednesday 5 May 2021. The children will have the opportunity to take on the role of a passenger on board the ship. We ask if you can support the awe and wonder of the day by providing your child with a costume suitable for a passenger in 1912. We have left it quite open in the hope you can create a costume from items the children already have rather than having to purchase anything new. We have put some ideas below as to the sort of thing you could wear, however feel free to be creative.

1st class passenger – Long dress, hat, gloves and boots or trousers, waistcoat, tie/ bow tie

2nd class passenger - long skirt and blouse/shirt or trousers waistcoat and flat cap.

3rd class passenger - school skirt or pinafore/ apron with plain white shirt or shirt and trousers.



During the day the children will be dining as 1st Class passengers on board the ship and we will provide a nut free snack and some squash to drink. If you would rather your child did not eat the snack, then please inform your child's class teacher.
